Canada's 150th Anniversary!

May 13, 2017 marks 100 years since the
apparitions of **Our Lady at Fatima** where she
asked all the people in the world to consecrate
themselves to her Immaculate Heart.

June 22, 2017 marks the 70th anniversary of
the consecration of the **Dominion of Canada to
Mary, Mother of God**, at an event that drew
250,000 pilgrims to Ottawa in 1947 and involved
all levels of government as well as cardinals and
bishops from around the world. **The consecration
of Canada to Mary** marked the climax of a four-
day Marian Congress, which was highlighted by a
radio address from Pope Pius XII in French and
English. A replica of the statue of Our Lady of the
Cape, travelled in procession from the shrine
throughout Quebec and Ontario, visiting 340
different parishes before arriving in Ottawa for the
1947 Congress.

The miraculous statue of Our Lady of the Cape was
officially crown as the **Queen of Canada** two times,
by papal degree.

Sister Lucia dos Santos of Fatima said, *"There
is no problem, I tell you, no matter how difficult it is
that we cannot resolve by the prayer of the Holy
Rosary."*

Top: "A Mari usque ad Mare"

Canada's official motto is "A Mari usque ad Mare,"
which translates as "From Sea to Sea."

It comes from Psalm 72:8, in Latin,
*Et dominabitur a mari usque ad mare, et a flumine
usque ad terminos terrae.*

In English, "He shall have dominion also from sea
to sea, and from the river unto the ends of the
earth."
